


Dear Sir:



- there now remains due and unpaid to plaintiff the sum of \$2,547.00 plus such further amounts as may accrue to the date of hearing
  - plaintiff has been denied visitation rights on \_\_\_\_\_
  - has violated the order since June 10, 1982, by failing to pay \$30.00 each and every week.

Plaintiff also requests that the defendant be ordered to assign his wages to satisfy the court order.

4) Wherefore, plaintiff demands that defendant be required to appear before this Court to show cause why he should not be adjudged in contempt of Court and for such other relief as to said Court may seem meet and just.
